Attention ALL Competitors

Class schedule is subject to change! It is the responsibility of each competitor to check the daily schedule of classes posted on notice boards at the show office. Championship presentations will take place after placing last class of division. Please remain at ring with your horse to receive your awards. All breaks will be announced at the show.

General Rules:

- 1. The management committee reserves the right to decide any point not covered in the rules and to correct any errors or make any alterations that may be necessary in the prize list.
- 2. The management committee reserves the right to remove any groom, owner, trainer, manager, or rider from the horse show without compensation should that individual exhibit dangerous or unsportsmanlike behavior or harm to a horse.
- 3. Any acts of discourtesy, or disobedience to the judges or officials by the owner, rider, manager, trainer, or groom shall disqualify them from further competition in the horse show and the owner shall forfeit all fees.
- 4. Inhumane treatment of a horse including polling, rapping, or other abuse shall not be tolerated. Violation of this rule
 - shall result in immediate disqualification, and forfeiture of all fees and prizes.
- 5. Competitors will not be issued numbers until waiver forms are received in the Show Office. Please enclose a completed Release and Waiver of Liability form with your entry form and fees
- 6. Numbers must be worn while mounted
- 7. HARD HATS AND ATTIRE
 - It is mandatory that all persons mounted on a horse anywhere on the competition grounds wear protective headgear secured with a safety harness permanently affixed to the helmet.

Equi-Cup Points Tally

Not all BEST shows are EquiCup shows, but we will follow the points distribution as follows.

Points will be awarded in qualifying classes as follows: 10, 8, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, and 1 providing there are at least eight riders who complete the course. If there are fewer than eight eligible ribbon winners, points will be awarded by the same scale using the lowest numbers. For example, if there are five ribbons awarded, the points will be 5, 4, 3, 2, and 1. If there are three, they will receive 3, 2 and 1 respectively.

We will tabulate points to 8th place at each of our shows in our divisions only. How many ribbons are awarded in each class will be at each individual show's discretion.

Not all classes at Equi-Cup shows count toward series finale awards. Each show is free to run any or all of the Equi-Cup divisions and classes as well as classes that are not part of the Equi-Cup Series. Points are tabulated only for classes listed on the Equi-Cup website. In the event of discrepancies in class specifics at individual shows Equi Cup Management reserves the right to distribute points at Equi-Cup's discretion.
